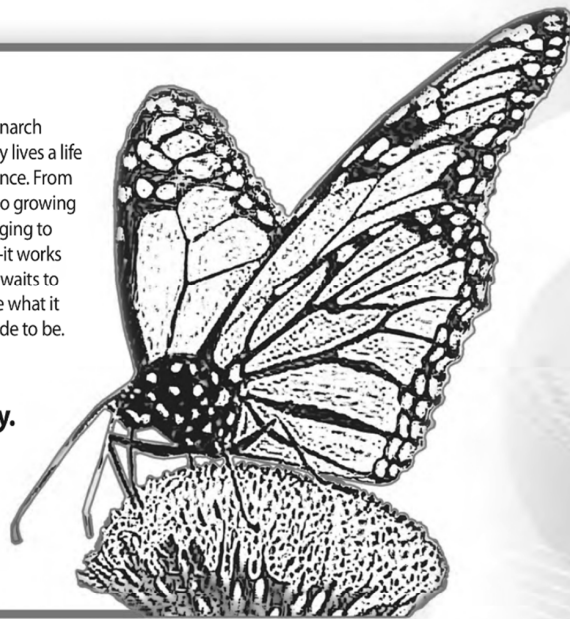
Patience
