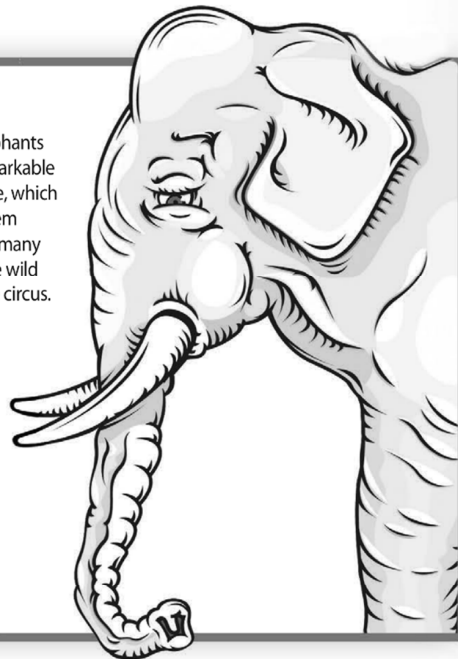
Obedience

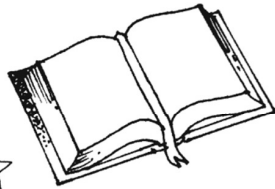

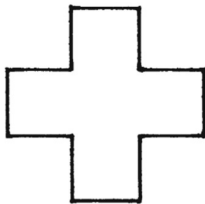
