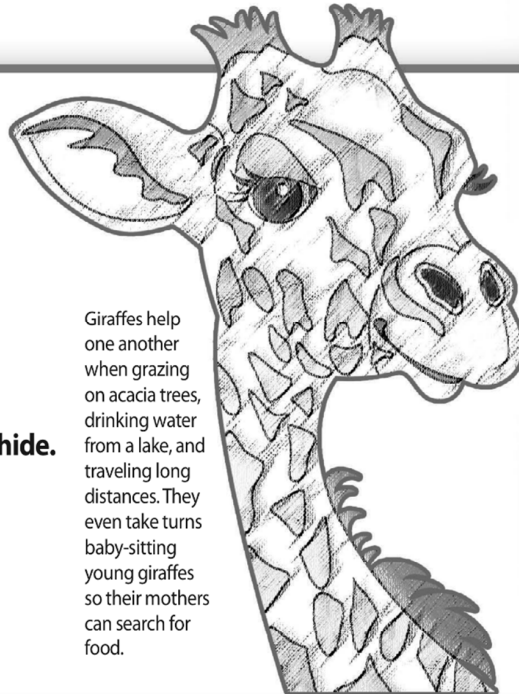
Availability
